

## Chilliwack Riding Club Horse Shows

### Horse Types:

Stock – Quarter horse, Appaloosa, Paints and similar types.

Hunter – Thoroughbred, Warm Blood and similar types.

Saddle – Saddlebreds, Morgans and similar types.

Pleasure – Arabs and similar types

In the case of cross-bred horses where the breeding includes two types or where the horse's breeding is not known, the owner/rider must determine in which type their horse most closely resembles and enter the appropriate class. No cross entry is permitted throughout the year.

### Class Definitions:

#### *Equitation – English or Western*

Walk, trot and canter and may be required to hand gallop both ways of the arena. The class is judged on riders seat and performance on handling the horse. This class may also be asked to complete a pattern or individual work, and back up on Judge's call.

#### *Pleasure – English or Western*

Walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the arena. The horse should show to be a pleasure to ride with very little resistance. Rein back at Judge's request.

#### *Show Hack*

Walk, trot, canter and hand gallop with lengthening and collection of every gait both ways of the arena. Back up may be requested for this class.

#### *Hunter Hack*

Hunter hack will be required to walk, trot, canter and hand gallop. Judged on flat work and the even balance of stride over two sets of jumps.

#### *Road Hack*

Road hack will be required to walk, trot, working trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the arena. This class is judged on the horse's suitability for road riding.

#### *Discipline Rail*

Walk, trot, canter both ways of the arena, other gaits may be requested at Judge's request.
